Pilots Launch with Artists and Cultural Organisations

Artcast4D pilots are launching in Issy-les-Moulineaux, Hounslow, Valencia, and Athens, bringing together artists, museums, and cultural organisations to create immersive experiences in public spaces, performance art, and tourism. These projects aim to deepen public engagement with cultural heritage while exploring the cutting edge of immersive experiences. Using AAAseed, an innovative open-source 2D/3D real-time engine, Artcast4D assesses the impact of this technology on the arts, helping boost the competitiveness of local cultural sectors.

Issy-les-Moulineaux Takes the Lead with Citizen Engagement


In Issy-les-Moulineaux, Artcast4D is teaming up with the French Museum of Playing Cards to bring immersive, interactive art to the city center. This pilot project invites both residents and professionals from the cultural and creative industries to co-create using Artcast4D technology, blending event promotion, cultural heritage, and real-time interactive experiences. The first community artwork, Fresco, was unveiled at the #Vivalssy festival during the European Night of Museums in May 2024.

Art in the Public Space: Hounslow's Creative Exploration

Hounslow, UK, is embracing Artcast4D's vision by bringing art into public spaces. Watermans Arts Centre will curate five artistic commissions, highlighting the accessibility of Artcast4D technology for non-specialist artists. With artists like Tendayi Vine, Tom Dale Dance Company, and Insectotropics experimenting with this tech, the projects—ranging from digital performances to long-term installations—promise to captivate audiences and strengthen cultural connections with twin town Issy-les-Moulineaux.
